Please make every effort to pre-squad for the shoot to enable us to plan for dinner and to schedule adequate referees. **A camping spot can be reserved by using the link in this program or call Robby at 904-254-0247.** We have water and electric hook-ups available for \$15.00 a day for one 30-amp hook-up. Practice rounds will be available at club member rates for all competitors the week of and during the shoot. The management reserves the right to refund, reject, or disqualify any contestant, who, in the management's

judgment, interferes with the administration, harmony, or sportsmanship of the shoot. Ear and eye protection is required for all competitors and skeet personnel.
